

## Helpful things for Made for More for CM/Created for a Purpose

1. Hosted a training gathering “practice party,” and also offer some take home kits for people who can’t make training. (We did our training the week of, so it would be fresh, but sent the details about 10 days before.)
2. Send out all the details via email and encourage everyone to thoroughly review before the Conference.

## Check-in Process (this what ended up working best for us):

1. Before the event, we had created rooms of girls based on our set up for us it ended up being about 18 girls per room. We grouped churches together, so most everyone had at least one familiar face.
2. Labels for check-in & pick-up
  - a. Each label had the Girl’s Name, Age Group, Room # Flower Group, and Photo Status
  - b. We made the label sheet so each Girl had two Labels side by side one for the woman and one for the girl.
  - c. Labels were sorted alphabetically by last name, so families were grouped together.
3. We had a table set off to the side for CFAP check-in

Check-in Table had the following items:

- Matching Labels with Girl’s Info – one for woman and one for girl
  - Colored Dot sticker – pre-labeled with D, R, L for Daisy, Rose, Lily
  - Smiley Face Stickers – for non-photo
  - List of all girls alphabetized by last name with room/group/photo info – so that Check-in volunteers could make notes for room adjustments, etc... We had a few people bring a different girl that originally registered as well as some girls that wanted to be with sisters or friends.
  - Pens for making notes
  - Each check-in person had a fun leis (we also had leis for volunteers helping with girls)
  - Signs designating lines by last name , i.e. A-D, F-L, M-S, T-Z
4. As the women/girls entered, they were encouraged to pick up their bag and make way to CFAP check-in table.
  5. As they approached the table, we had volunteering asking them to remove their name tags from their pouch so we could stick the labels on their name tag – ASK FOR THE PAPER PART 😊
    - a. We stuck all the labels on the nametag of both the woman and the girl
      - i. Color Dot for group, Label with Name & Info
    - b. Smiley Stickers on the front of the non-photo girls.

## Created for a Purpose Time

1. We had 3 leaders in the rooms with 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Graders
2. We had 2 leaders in most of the rooms with 6-8<sup>th</sup> graders- a few of the groups had 3 leaders. 9-12<sup>th</sup>. We ended up keeping all our 9-12 graders together – it was a bigger group but it was fine.
3. We used the examples from our practice party in the classrooms.

4. All the supplies were laid out in advance and Sarah Ellen did an excellent job in the morning training explaining how to pace the time, help the girls choose their papers, and about the discipleship time. It was great.
5. In the Large Room, each group had Group sign on stick so they could hold up high and be easily found in the large gathering room as well as a copy of their roll. We had them sit with Daisies closet to the front and the oldest Lilies toward the back.
6. LT welcomed the girls and gave them a quick overview of the time. Then we did the songs with motions and the LT introduced Ingram and prayed for her talk. After her talk, LT dismissed the girls group by group to their rooms.
7. We had a person stationed in the halls answering questions, helping as needed, and just checking in on the groups.
8. PICK UP –in the classrooms – since the rooms were listed on the mom’s/women’s label – they were able to walk to the rooms easily to match up with the girls. We had volunteers stationed along the way.
9. PICK UP – one volunteer stood at the door and read off the name from the nametag of the woman and then we matched them up.
10. The girls had cute CFAP bags to keep up with all their goodies.

#### **Here is the sample email I sent:**

Hello Friends,

We are so thankful that you are serving with us at Made for More! We have 234 amazing girls coming with their mothers/women to worship with us and hear from God’s Word.

How fun for these girls to get to come and do a “mini” Created for a Purpose! You are the reason this is possible! Thank you!

#### **What will I be doing? Watch [Discipleship Training Here](#)**

You and another adult will lead a group of 18 girls in the project and discipleship time praying for girls from Terenga Village. The groups are divided by 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade, 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade, and 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade. We will start together in C316 for songs and teaching and then divide up into assigned classrooms with our groups to do the project. At the end of the session, women will come to the classroom to meet up with the girls.

#### **How will I know how to do the Project?**

We will have a **training session from 8:00-8:50 a.m. on Saturday morning in C316**. We will cover all the details of the day as well as prepare for the project time together. If you have daughter/daughters with you, she can join us.

If anyone is in the area and want to pick up materials to practice at home *let us know*, we will have them available for pick up in the church office.

## Who will be in my group?

You will have a roll listing all the girls in your group. Each group will have about 18 girls between the ages of 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grades, 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grades, or 9-12<sup>th</sup> Grades. They will be from all different churches, cities, and states!

## What is the schedule for the Created for a Purpose session?

10:15-10:30 a.m. | Transition from Sanctuary to C316

We will invite girls to exit the rear of the Sanctuary and have some of you stationed along the route toward the Children's building.

Connect with Groups | Hold up your sign and gather girls in your group around you, mark off their names on the roll.

10:30-10:50 a.m. | Large Group | Songs and teaching on ACTS prayer

10:50-10:55 a.m. | Transition to Classroom for Project | Check Roll Again

10:55-12:10 p.m. | Project | Paper Folding | [Watch Video Here](#)

12:10-12:20 p.m. | Discipleship Time | [Watch Video Here](#) | How to pray using the ACTS model from teaching for the girls in Teranga Village.

12:20-12:30 p.m. | Transition to Youth Pit | Reconnect with Women

Each girl will have a label on her name tag that matches the woman who brought her. You will hold up your sign with group name. Women/Girls will meet up and you'll check off roll that the mother and daughter had matching labels.
