The Power of Hope Bethany Belue

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope. — Romans 15:13

I stood in my tiny New York City apartment, looking in the mirror with a tear-stained face. Just days before, the man I thought I would marry ended our relationship. My heart was crushed.
