***We Do Not Lose Heart:  
God Is at Work Around Us, In Us, and Through Us  
2 Corinthians 2:14-4:16***

lose heart – faint, lack courage, be weary

God Is at Work **Around Us** (key verses: 2 Cor. 2:14-16)

God Is at Work **In Us** (key verse: 2 Cor. 3:18)

God Is at Work **Through Us** (key verses: 2 Cor. 4:6-7)

## Responsive Reading

Leader: But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of Him everywhere. (2:14)

People: **For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and those who are perishing, (2:15)**

Leader: to one a fragrance from death to death, to the other a fragrance from life to life. Who is sufficient for these things? (2:16)

People: **Not that we are sufficient in ourselves to claim anything as coming from us, but our sufficiency is from God. (3:9)**

Leader: Now if the ministry of death carved in letters on stone, came with such glory...will not the ministry of the Spirit have even more glory? (3:7-8) We are not like Moses, who would put a veil over his face so that the Israelites might not gaze at the outcome of what was being brought to an end. (3:13)

People: **And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit. (3:18)**

Leader: Therefore, having this ministry by the mercy of God, we do not lose heart. (4:1)

People: **For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. (4:6)**

Leader: But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us. We are afflicted

People: **but not crushed**

Leader: perplexed

People: **but not driven to despair**

Leader: persecuted

People: **but not forsaken**

Leader: struck down

People: **but not destroyed (4:7-9)**

Leader: always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus can also be manifested in our bodies. (4:10)

People: **For the love of Christ controls us, because we have concluded this: that one has died for all, therefore all have died, and he died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised. (5:14-15)**

Leader: So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. (4:16)

People: **For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison. (4:17)**

Leader: as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal. (4:18)

People: **for we walk by faith, not by sight (5:7)**

People: **Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. (5:17)**

Leader: in Christ God was reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. (5:20)

Leader: And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work. (9:8)

People: **My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness. Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. (12:9)**
